This study shows that UG in Computer Science 15.65 percent of users, it followed by UG in English, Zoology and commerce secured 14.78 percent. Under graduate in Commerce and PG in Tamil are hold third level with 13.97 percent. Besides this analysis brings that 40 percent, next 27.82 percent of users visit the library in once in a week, the users visit the library once in a fortnight is 20.86 percent is observed from the study.

graduate in Commerce and PG in Tamil are hold third level with 13.97 percent. UG in Physics holds 12.17 percents reveal from the study fig -1.






Fig-2 Purpose of respondents visiting the Library




Fig-3 User satisfaction of Library Services
